## Summary of Position:

Reporting to the Emergency Placement Resource House Manager (EPR-HM), the Awasis Emergency Placement Resource Worker (EPRW) is responsible for the day-to-day functioning of the program. The EPRW is responsible for implementing all aspects of the day-to-day functioning of the program. The EPRW is expected to provide ongoing, culturally sensitive care while adhering to organizational policies and procedures. A major focus of their work with young people is to always be a positive role model and to intervene purposefully in the young people's daily life. EPRW works from a needs-based, trauma informed, relational child and youth care approach as per the organization's expectations and standards.

## Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Emergency First Aid and CPR Level C (training will be provided)
- 2+ years working knowledge of Child and Family Services Standards and Regulations preferred.
- Experience working with children and vulnerable youth.
- Strong relationship building skills and experience in de-escalation.
- Knowledge of trauma and resilience informed care
- ASIST Certificate (Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training) preferred
- Mental Health & Safe Talk will be considered an asset
- Knowledge of Indigenous customs, traditions, and beliefs will be considered an asset
- Possession of a valid driver's license.
- Ability to work collaboratively as part of a multi-systemic team.
- Excellent problem solving and conflict resolution skills.
- Strong organizational and time management skills.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
